- ▷ School enrollment and record transfers
- ▷ Human services benefits
- ▷ Police reports and court records
- ▷ Parks and recreation centers
- ▷ Voter registration records
- ▷ Bank accounts
- ▷ Libraries
- ▷ Special protections on Comcast, Xcel Energy, and other utility accounts

The Colorado Address Confidentiality Program (ACP)

is a statewide program that is available to survivors at no cost.

Program Eligibility

1. An applicant must be a survivor of actual or threatened domestic violence, sexual offenses, and/or stalking who fears for their safety.
2. The survivor must have relocated within the past 90 days or have a plan to relocate.
3. The survivor must provide evidence of victimization.

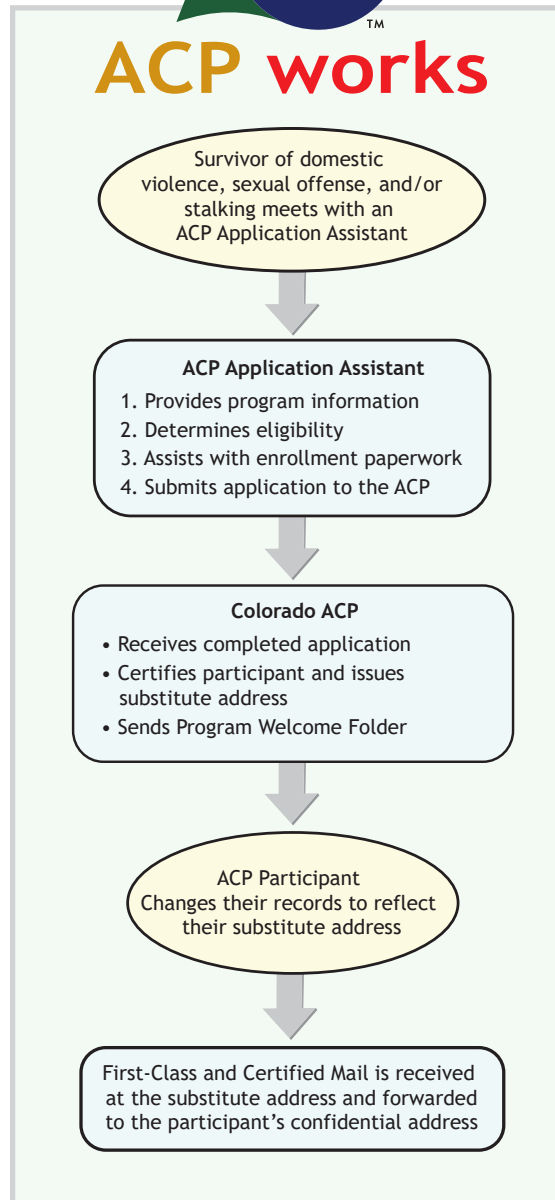
Program Enrollment

Those interested in enrolling in the ACP must meet with an Application Assistant. Application Assistants are direct service providers who are trained and registered by the ACP. A list of Application Assistants and their agencies can be found on the ACP website.

ACP works



Participant Certification

ACP certification is valid for four years. Participants may cancel their enrollment at any time and may renew for additional four-year terms.

Participant Voter Registration

ACP participants can keep their voter registration information out of public record by registering or re-registering to vote as an “ACP Voter.”

Service of Process

The ACP is authorized to accept personal service on behalf of program participants.

Authorization Cards

ACP authorization cards verify program enrollment and authorize the legal use of the substitute address. ACP authorization cards are issued for each enrolled participant, and are included in the Welcome Folder.
